TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (AS AMENDED) - PLANNING APPEAL AGAINST REFUSAL OF A HOUSEHOLDER APPLICATION

I refer to the above details. I am writing to let you know that an appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the Council's decision to refuse (planning permission) for the proposed development described above. The Planning Inspectorate will publish appeal documentation, including copies of representations received, on the Planning Portal website. All information provided in your representation, including your name and address, will be published. If you object to publication in this way, please contact the Planning Inspectorate directly.

The Planning Inspectorate aims to deal with appeals which follow the procedure described above within 8 weeks of the appeal starting date.
