I am writing to support the idea that there be an extra CAP meeting before the Regulatory Committee meets, not only so that it can see the extra information which has been requested on density and amenity space, but also so that it can have the opportunity to see the two reports on Chepstow - that of English Heritage and our Conservation Officers and Design Team.

Also, we feel it important that one of our Conservation Officers speaks at the CAP meeting - after all, they are experts in the field and their views ought to be heard and their expertise used to the full.

Finally, we feel that a 3 sentence report of CAPs findings is insufficient for members of the Regulatory Committee to gain a proper understanding of CAPs assessment of Chepstow. Therefore we feel that a proper independent report ought to be sent to Regulatory Committee Members.
