Property Licensing Consultation

Redbridge Council is consulting on proposals to introduce two licensing schemes for private rented properties. Selective Licensing requires properties rented to single family households in certain wards to be licensed. This protects tenants by improving housing standards and the management of private rented accommodation and reducing anti-social behaviour. The first scheme includes Valentines and Clementswood wards. The second scheme includes the wards; Goodmayes, Snaresbrook, Newbury, Cranbrook, Chadwell, Aldborough, Loxford, Roding, Mayfield, Seven Kings, Fairlop and Church End. Public meetings are being held across the borough.
