An opportunist criminal has taken advantage of an open car and made off with property on a motor bike. Please double check that your car is lock before leaving it we do have people walking down the street trying car doors.

External letter boxes can be more at risk for mail theft resulting in fraud. Regularly check that they have not been padded out to make steeling the mail easier, and if you ever get unusual letter regarding loans finances etc contact the Bank immediately and report it to action fraud.

Male has been seen in Warwick Road trying car doors to see if they have been left open. The Male seemed to be focusing on

Audis (Q5) and it's believed that he may have had devices to aid him in unlocking doors of this make of cars.

Thanks to an observant neighbour the male left with nothing, and there was no damage to the car.

If you ever see people walking down the street trying car doors call 999 immediately. Double check that your car is locked at night and that no items on value are left in the car or on display over night.

Please respect people that say no to trick or treaters' look for signs that people are taking part like a pumpkin at the door and never let your children go out alone.
