Rogue Traders

Please be aware there has been an increase in rogue traders around Wanstead and Snaresbrook. Traders will knock on your doors offering to carry out works for things like your roof, garden and general house repairs. You will often feel like you are getting a good deal.

These people will often offer to begin carrying out works immediately or within the next couple of days.

Rogue traders will often lie about repairs you need ie, "you need a new roof", offering no written cancellation rights, no invoice, no proprietor details, cheaper price for cash, offer only open today

You can check out builders through organisations like "Federation of Master Builders", and other routes however, these are not exhaustive. If you are unsure you can also contact Trading Standards and the police.

If unsure do not use them. Be very wary of anyone that knocks on your door and offers to start work immediately. These people will often target the elderly.

Theft from MV - Mercedes estate, items taken no damage to vehicle
Theft from MV - front/rear index plates
Att Burg Non D - wooden door to an outdoor storage shed x2
Veh Interfere - Citroen Van attempted brake in
C/Dam Vehicle - van deliberately scratched after parking in the "wrong place"

Burg Dwell - Suspect unknown has used a brick to smash a ground floor rear window. Suspect has then reached through the window and retrieved keys. Suspect has then used the keys to open rear glazed door and entered the property. Alarm at the premises then sounded and suspect made off across gardens.
