Below is a brief breakdown of burglary related crime which has occurred in Snaresbrook Ward in the last seven days

Byron Avenue	Burglary-D	29/09/17	Gained entry through rear of property method ur
Sylvan Road	Burglary-D	04/10/17	Gained entry through rear ground floor window
Osprey Close	Burglary-D	06/10/17	Gained entry but scared off by residents, earring
High Road Wanstead	Attempt Burglary	08/10/17	Front door damaged, entry not gained
Raymond Avenue	Burglary-D	11/10/17	Gained entry through rear patio door, jewellery t
Bressey Grove	Burglary Non-D	11/10/17	Shed broken into, locks broken. Nothing taken
Bressey Grove	Burglary Non-D	12/10/17	Shed broken into, Bike taken

Key:

An 'Attempt' marker in the crime type field indicates that a suspect has tried to break into a premise but was unsuccessful for reasons unknown

A 'Non-D' marker indicates that the premise broken into was a building that is not normally a residence like a garage or a shop.

A 'Burglary-D' marker indicates that the building broken into was a home or a dwelling.
