Below is a brief breakdown of burglary related crime which has occurred in Snaresbrook Ward in the last seven days

Street name	Crime type	Event date	Comments
New Wanstead	Attempt burglary	17/10/17	Gained entry through rear window of property
Nightingale Lane	Attempt burglary	21/10/17	Failed attempt to take car keys through front letter-box
High View Road	Burglary-D	22/10/17	Entry through front door, tools left on site were taken
High View Road	Burglary-D	22/10/17	Entry through front door, tools left on site were taken
Wellesley Road	Burglary-D	23/10/17	Shed broken into, bikes taken
Bressey Grove	Burglary-D	24/10/17	Entry though back window possibly left unlocked, jewellery taken
Bressey Grove	Burglary-D	25/10/17	Entry through back door, cash and jewellery taken

Key:

An 'Attempt' marker in the crime type field indicates that a suspect has tried to break into a premise but was unsuccessful for reasons unknown A 'Non-D' marker indicates that the premise broken into was a building that is not normally a residence like a garage or a shop.

A 'Burglary-D' marker indicates that the building broken into was a home or a dwelling.

Orchard Close	Vehicle-I	08/10/17	Vehicle taken. But quickly pursued by police. Suspect arrested.
Broadwalk	T/O/M/V	23.10.17	Vehicle taken from drive
Woodbine Place	Vehicle-I	24/10/17	Vehicle interfered with, damage to wing mirrors
Gordon Road	T/F/M/V	25/10/17	Searched by suspect and items taken from within the vehicle
Bressey Grove	T/F/M/V	26/10/17	Tools stolen from within vehicle

Key:

A 'T/F/M/V' marker in the crime type field indicates that a (Theft From Motor Vehicle) has taken place. This mean a vehicle has been broken into in order to take object/s from inside without permission from the vehicles owner.

A 'Vehicle-I' marker indicates that vehicle interference has taken place. A suspect has tried to gain entry to the vehicle without success and without causing damage, i.e. pushing a window down.

A 'T/O/M/V' marker indicates that a vehicle has been taken without the owners permission.
