In an emergency always call 999

Police Emergency?

See something suspicious or threatening, but don't want to call 999?

Then dial 101; this non-urgent police number is can be really useful for reporting suspicious activity. If the operator believes the situation is more serious/urgent, they will elevate the call to 999 anyway.

Issues such as vans slowly touring the area, suspected bogus callers or anti-social behaviour can all be reported to 101.

Don't be shy about calling, the police are pleased to be alerted about suspicious activity and can rely on such information for background intelligence.

Try to remember to record vehicle number plates, if applicable - these can be particularly useful, but be discreet about it!

There was recently an attempt to forcibly gain entry to a house on the Counties Estate by a man ringing the doorbell and barging in when the occupant opened the door. Luckily the intruder was repelled and the police called.

With so many mail order deliveries, we must remember the general precaution of visually verifying callers prior to opening doors. Use peepholes, letterboxes and/or side windows and for those with a porch, to keep the porch doors locked too.

Membership costs £5.00 (£1.00 for OAPs) and runs from 1st July-30th June regardless of the application date, with applications from January entitled to a 50% discount. Membership is per household (not per person) and the membership fee + any donation should be remitted to 27 Hereford Road. To ensure our records are kept up to date and you continue to received notices etc, existing members should also use this form to renew.

Payment can be in cash, by cheque made payable to "The Counties Residents Association" or by standing order (form on request). A receipt and membership card will be issued shortly afterwards.

By completing this form and returning it with your fee, you unconditionally accept the terms of the Constitution of the CRA (details on our website) and confirm that your contact details may be kept on a secure and private computerised register of members (for internal use only).
