

Extra protection for historic Wanstead

Wanstead Grove is one of Redbridge's most important heritage areas and it will now be given special protection.

Redbridge Council has designated Wanstead Grove a Conservation Area meaning that the Council has more

control over things like demolition, minor developments and the protection of trees.

The area includes The Avenue, Buckingham Road, Gloucester Road, Grove Park, Hereford Road, Leicester Road, Nightingale Lane, Nutter Lane, Rutland

Road, Stanstead Road and Warwick Road.

The site is home to a number of architectural gems, including the 18th century house of Applegarth, 1890s Arts and Crafts almshouses and the Grade II listed Art Deco apartment - The Shrubbery.
