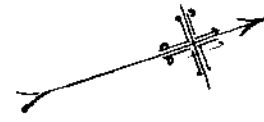

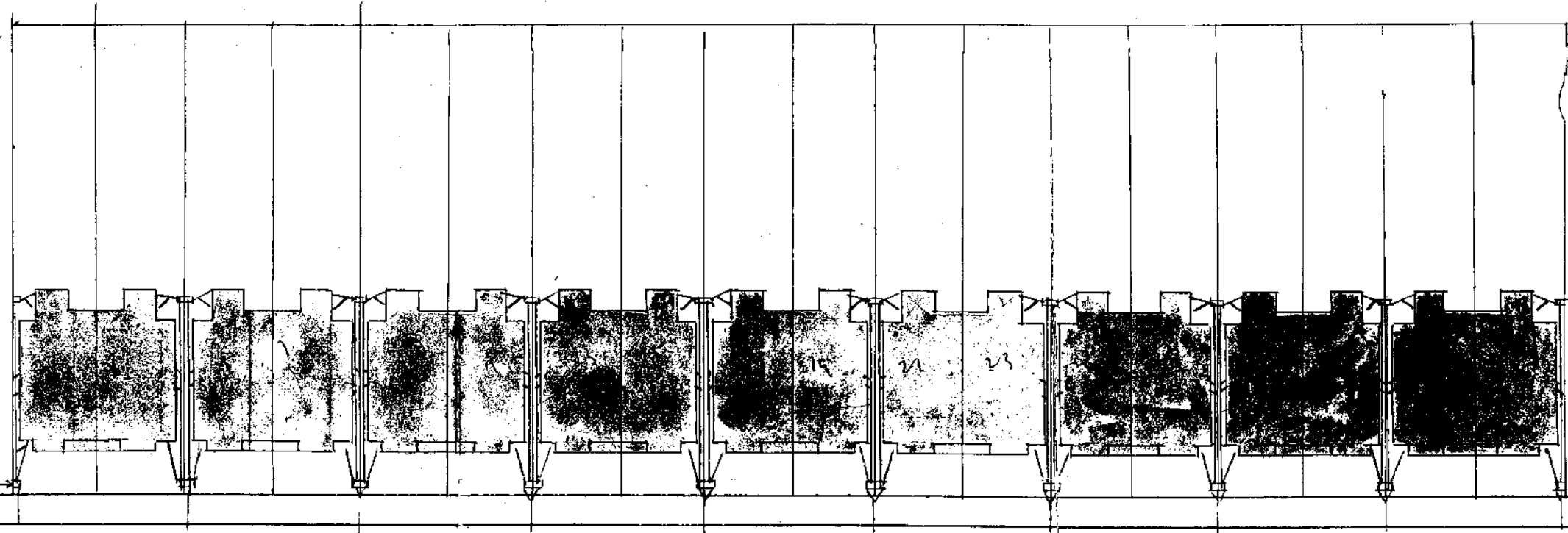
BLOCK-PLAN SHOWING DRAINS, ETC.

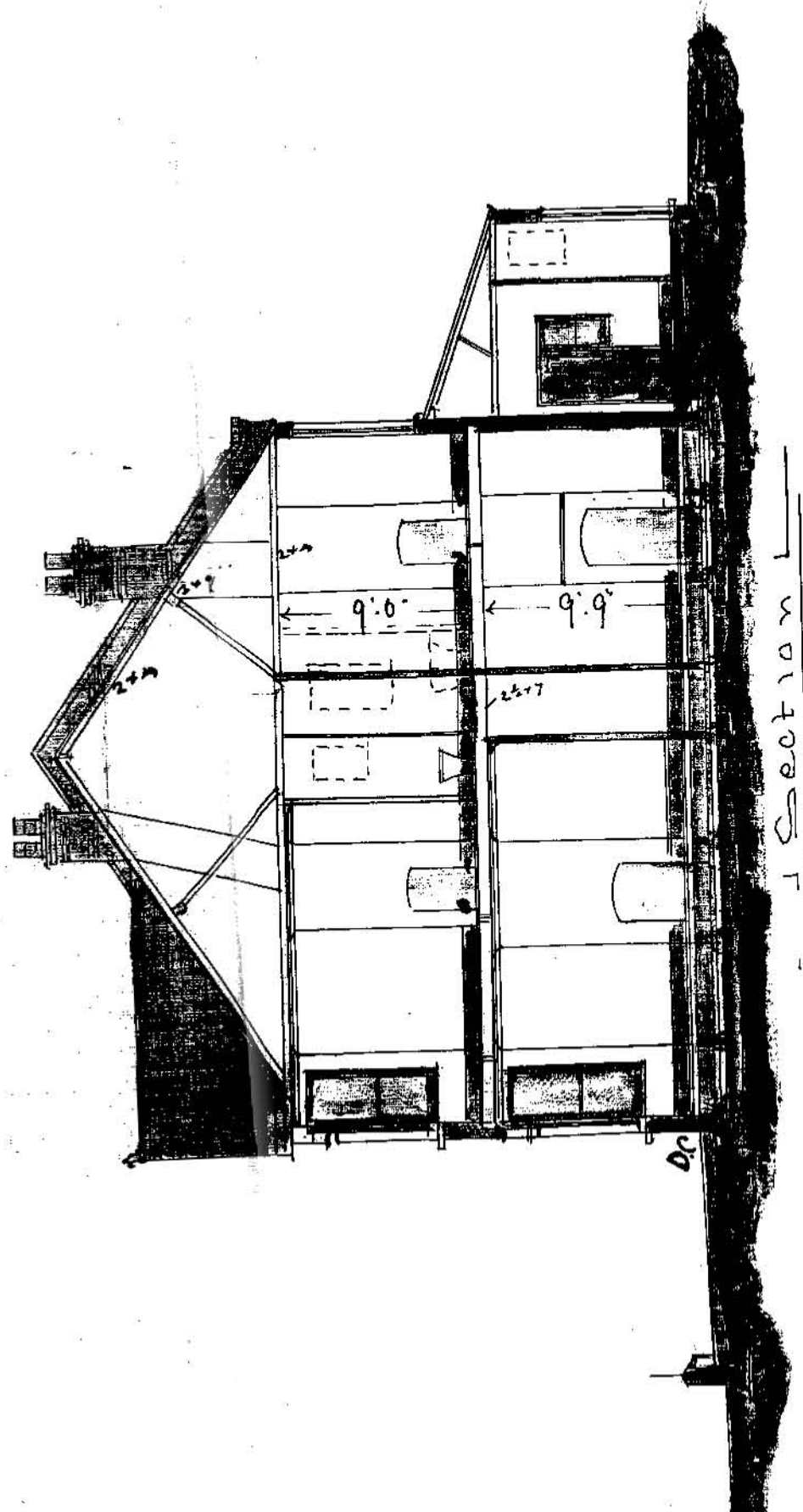
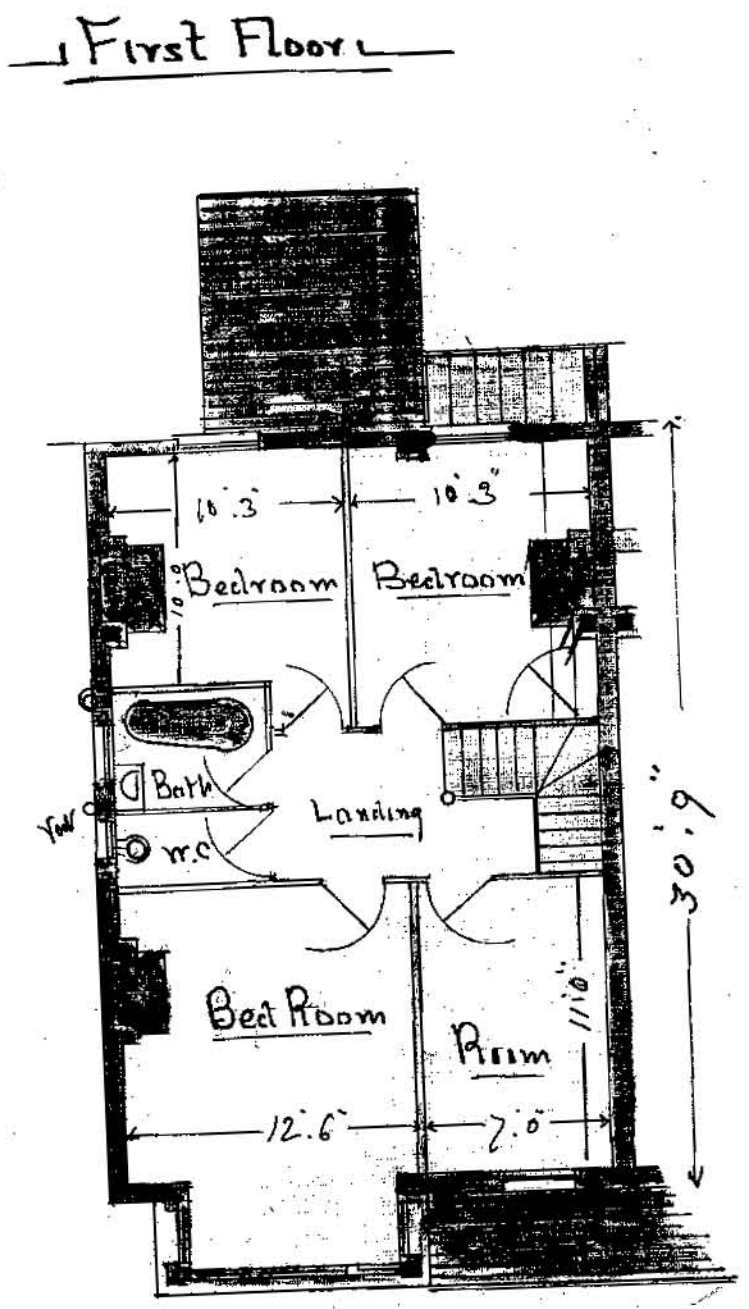
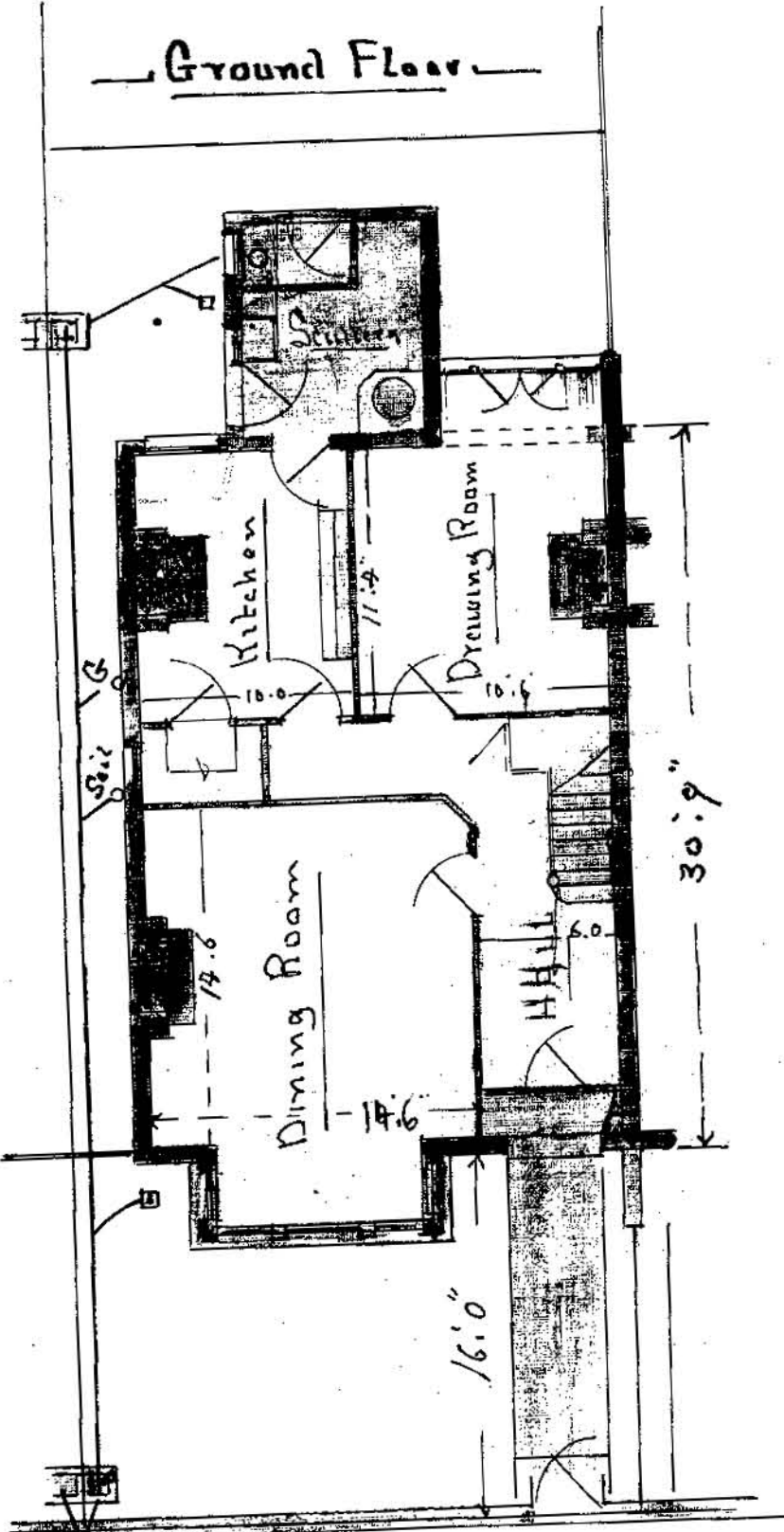
