Below is an indication of burglary and vehicle crime figures for the last week. Please understand that these figures were correct for your local area at the time of this letters creation. Figures may have changed from this time to when this letter was sent out.

Below is a brief breakdown of burglary related crime which has occurred in Snaresbrook Ward in the last seven days

| Street name | Crime type | Event date | Comments |
|---------------|------------|------------|---|
| Malford Court | Burglary-D | 21/09/17 | Gained entry through ground floor window |
| Eagle Lane | Burglary-D | 23/09/17 | Gained entry through rear door |
| Bressey Grove | Burglary-D | 27/09/17 | Vehicle keys stolen from address and car taken work |

Key:

An 'Attempt' marker in the crime type field indicates that a suspect has tried to break into a premise but was unsuccessful for reasons unknown

A 'Non-D' marker indicates that the premise broken into was a building that is not normally a residence like a garage or a shop.

A 'Burglary-D' marker indicates that the building broken into was a home or a dwelling.

| Malcolm Way | T/F/M/V | 25/09/17 | Vehicle broken into, tools taken |
| Wellesley Road | T/F/M/V | 26/09/17 | Vehicle broken into, tools taken |
